## **MOUNT AIRY ARCHITECTURAL SURVEY UPDATE**

**Mount Airy, NC, July 6, 2018 –**

In 2017 the City of Mount Airy received a Historic Preservation Fund grant from the N.C. Department of Natural and Cultural Resources State Historic Preservation Office in order to update its architectural survey, which dates to the 1980s, and survey additional historic resources inside the city limits. The city's contractor, Dan Pezzoni of Landmark Preservation Associates, will present the findings of the survey at a meeting to be held at the **Reeves Community Center – Kidz Club (lower level entrance from Cherry Street parking lot)** on **July 26, 2018** from **6:00 – 7:00 PM**. Mr. Pezzoni will give an illustrated talk on the survey and will discuss preliminary recommendations for the state's Study List. The Study List is a list of properties and areas that may be eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The National Register places no obligations or restrictions on private owners using private resources to maintain or alter their properties. National Register listing should not be confused with local historic property and historic district designations. These designations are made by a local governing board on the recommendation of a local historic preservation commission.
