

Safety Guidelines

Facility

- Everyone must purchase an activity pass. Rate are listed below.
 - Day passes: Adult Resident - \$5.00 Youth Resident - \$3.00
 Adult Non-Resident - \$7.00 Youth Non-Resident - \$4.00
- Reservations must be made prior to pool use (Call-in only). Reservations need to be 24 hours in advance. Reservations for Saturday, Sunday, and Monday will be taken on Friday.
- All patrons must sign a waiver and must not exhibit any symptoms of COVID-19
- Anyone exhibiting any symptoms will not be allowed to enter. Symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle and body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea.
- All patrons must enter through the tunnel lot. Individuals who need to use the handicap entrance may call RCC and a staff member will let them in.
- All patrons must be at least 18 years or older to be at the facility on their own.
- Anyone 17 years or younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. The parent/guardian is responsible for helping to maintain social distancing.
- Lap swimming and aqua exercise will be blocked into 1-hour segments.
- Open swim times will be available in 2-hour segments.
- Pools will be cleared and railing, doors, etc. will be cleaned/disinfected at the end of each segment.
- The entrance, decks, and locker rooms will have 6' social distancing markers/signs.
- "Family-unit" sections will be marked on each pool deck.
- Social distancing will be enforced on the pool deck and in the water. Patrons are encouraged to wear facing coverings when they are not in the water.
- Kiddie pool will remain closed.
- RCC locker room showers and saunas will remain closed.
- RCC will not provide individuals will exercise equipment, floatation devices, towels or chairs. Patrons will be allowed to bring their own chairs.
- Vending Machines and water fountains will not be available. Patrons may bring snacks and drinks as long as the items/containers follow facility guidelines. No glass bottles or containers are allowed.

Staff

- Daily temperature screenings and questionnaire will be done prior to the shift beginning for all staff.
- Gate attendant is encouraged to wear a mask and gloves.
- Lifeguards will have a mask readily available in the case of a close patron interaction.
- Lifeguards will have a 6' diameter around each stand for social distancing. Guard rotations should be the only time an individual should come inside the circle.
- One guard will be a "rover" meaning they will be cleaning and ensure patrons are practicing the social distancing.
