## RECYCLING KNOW HOW

Do NOT bag any material in your recycle cart.

Place your cart at the edge of the street with the handle facing your house – so it opens street side. Household recycling is offered curbside only.

Automated collection requires your cart be spaced at least 3 feet from other carts and objects.
