PUBLIC FORUM:

Mayor Niland declared the public forum open.

Martha Truskolaski, 731 North Main Street (city resident): Mentioned the need for public restrooms in the 400th block of Main Street.

Grant Welch: Thanked the Board for the Easter Brothers Mural downtown and their approval for the grant to help the mural become a reality.

With no other speakers, Mayor Niland declared the public forum closed.

NEW BUSINESS:

a) Board to Discuss Appointment of Mayor Pro Tempore:

Mayor Niland asked for nominations for the position of Mayor Pro Tempore.

Commissioner Koch made a motion to appoint Commissioner Cawley as Mayor Pro Tempore and it was not approved unanimously.

Commissioner Cawley appreciated the nomination, however, he isn't interested in serving as Mayor Pro Tempore.

Commissioner Cawley made a motion to appoint Commissioner Wood as Mayor Pro Tempore and it was approved unanimously.

b) Board to Discuss Process to Fill Vacant Commissioner At-Large Seat:

Mayor Niland opened this item for Board discussion.

Commissioner Yokeley asked when the filing period for the 2022 election would be. Mayor Niland mentioned that the filing period should be in December and the primary would be May with the election in November.

Commissioner Yokeley suggested the Board wait to fill this seat until the filing period for the 2022 primary to see who files and possibly choose from those candidates to fill the seat. He doesn't want to appoint someone who doesn't want to run for reelection.

Commissioner Wood suggested asking citizens for their input on which process the Board uses to fill the seat.

Commissioner Cawley mentioned that the State has made it clear that the expectation is the decision to fill a seat be done in a timely manner. In the past, the Board has requested those who were interested, to send in statements of interest and the Board decide from those and he wasn't a fan of this process.

Commissioner Yokeley made a motion to wait until the December filing period is over and consider appointing one of those candidates to fill the vacant Commissioner at-Large seat for discussion.

Commissioner Cawley doesn't agree with appointing someone who has filed because it looks like an endorsement from the Board. He feels they need to move forward and make a decision as quickly as they can.

Commissioner Koch stated that even though this isn't the best way, he suggested those who are interested, to send a letter of interest/resume to the City by a certain date.

Commissioner Yokeley doesn't feel anyone appointed would run for the seat in 2022. After the filing period, there will be a large number of people who would be committed and have a strong interest in serving.

Commissioner Wood stated they need to define a process and she asked the City Manager if there are other cities who have appointed someone to give this Board an idea.

Barbara Jones stated that individual municipalities make their decisions on what process they go through and those processes are what the Board has discussed tonight. She will be glad to check with some other municipalities to see what processes they have used.

Commissioner Wood feels that the person who they appoint needs to be serious about the job-not just a fill in-and needs to commit to run for the seat in the election.

With a three to two vote, Commissioner Yokeley's motion failed:

Vote Aye: Commissioners Yokeley and Wood

Vote Nay: Commissioners Koch and Cawley, Mayor Niland

(Mayor Niland voted to be the tiebreaker)

Commissioner Koch made a motion for those individuals who are interested in being appointed to the Commissioner at-Large seat, to send a letter of interest/resume to the City Clerk postmarked by September 30, 2021 for discussion.

Commissioner Yokeley would like those who apply to speak at a meeting as to why they feel they would be the best candidate.

Mayor Niland stated that between this meeting and that date, they can figure out the process to which the Board wishes to use.

Commissioner Cawley doesn't feel they should wait until September.

Commissioner Koch amended his motion for interested individuals to send their letter of interest/resume to the City Clerk postmarked by August 15, 2021 and it was approved unanimously.

Commissioner Yokeley still feels those who apply should come to a meeting to speak in person to explain why they feel they would be the best candidate. Then the Board could decide on how to vote.

Commissioner Yokeley made a motion for those who apply for the vacant Commissioner at-Large seat to attend the Board Meeting on September 2, 2021 to speak publically as to why the applicant feels they would be the best candidate and it was approved unanimously.

Mayor Niland stated the Board hasn't said they will make a decision that night after those applicants speak--the Board can decide at a later meeting.

OTHER BUSINESS:

City Dump Truck Discussion:

Commissioner Koch asked Mitch Williams to give a short explanation as to why the City has so many dump trucks. He asked if those trucks that are single-use could be made into multiuse trucks or if they are going to be dedicated to sand or salt, put that on an older truck. Is there a way to make it more efficient and get better/more use out of the vehicles.

Mitch Williams explained that Public Works has a total of 14 dump trucks in its fleet. The models range from 1992 to 2020 with an average age of 20 years and an average of 47,000 miles. The trucks from the 90s have a lot of ongoing maintenance including highly deteriorating bodies. Eleven dump trucks are used by the Streets Division with at least two to three being used daily. In addition, during leaf season, two to three of these trucks are used to pull leaf machines. The ultimate determining factor for having 10 trucks in the Streets Division is snow/inclement weather. The remaining truck in the Street Division could be removed from the fleet but other City Divisions occasionally borrow dump trucks so having an extra is beneficial.

Two dump trucks are used daily by the Utilities Maintenance Division and there is one dump truck located at the Wastewater Treatment Plant to haul sludge to the concrete pad.

The recent leaf machine that was purchased has a hook lift dump truck, which allows a dump truck to be used for multiple purposes. The plan over the next several years is to replace a few of the old dump trucks with this new system. This would perhaps allow for the removal of a truck or two from the fleet in the coming years.

Public Works staff evaluates the need for replacement every year during the budget process and will be very responsible with dump truck replacement requests.

REMARKS BY OFFICIALS:

Commissioner Cawley: No comments.

Commissioner Koch: In early 2000s, the parking lot between Moore and Oak was totally renovated with the city managing the project and the MSD paying for materials. Also, with the downtown restrooms, the city managed that project and MSD funds paid for it.

Commissioner Yokeley: Congratulations to Marie Wood for being appointed as Mayor Pro Tempore. Thoughts and prayers to the family of Judge Bud Oliver. He was a good friend.

Commissioner Wood: Thanked the Board for appointing her as Mayor Pro Tempore. Judge Oliver was a special man and he will be missed.

Barbara Jones: No comments.

Hugh Campbell: Recognized his mother who was in attendance.

Mayor Niland: Thoughts and prayers to the family of Judge Oliver. He was a great man and will be missed.

Congratulations to Marie Wood for being appointed as Mayor Pro Tempore.

Mentioned that the Easter Brothers Mural Dedication program was very remarkable.

RECESS:

Commissioner Koch made a motion to recess to August 5, 2021 +6:00 pm for the Regular Board Meeting and it was approved unanimously.
