

# GREATER MOUNT AIRY SPORTS HALL OF FAME NOMINATION APPLICATION

**ESTABLISHED:** In order to officially recognize the Greater Mount Airy area's long and storied sports history, the Greater Mount Airy Sports Hall of Fame is hereby established. Individuals who are selected for induction will be elected according to the criteria listed below, beginning with the first annual class in February, 2003. Members will have their names engraved on a monument.

**THE DEFINED AREA:** The defined area of the Greater Mount Airy Sports Hall of Fame will consist of the City Limits of Mount Airy, inclusive of the Mount Airy City Schools District and the one mile Extra Territorial Jurisdiction.

**ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION:** Persons elected to membership must have had a recognized career as an athlete, coach, administrator, referee, umpire or other official. If being recognized as a coach, administrator, referee, umpire or other official in a sports program in the defined area, and still active in their craft, the nominee must have been involved as one of these individuals for a minimum of 25 years. In both cases, the person's career must have brought recognition to the individual and the area by their involvement, and contributed to the promotion and success of sports in the area by their actions. The person must be of good character and reputation, must have upheld the ideals of good sportsmanship, and must have been a resident of the defined area by birth or relocation. The maximum number for each bi-annual class will be four (4), who may be living or awarded posthumously. In order to be elected to membership a nominee may receive no more than one dissenting vote from the Committee.

**THE GRANITE CITY AWARD:** Each year the Selection Committee may select one (1) person to receive The Granite City Award. This person will be selected on the basis of their contributions to the promotion of sports in the defined area other than as an athlete, coach or administrator.
